Director's Note

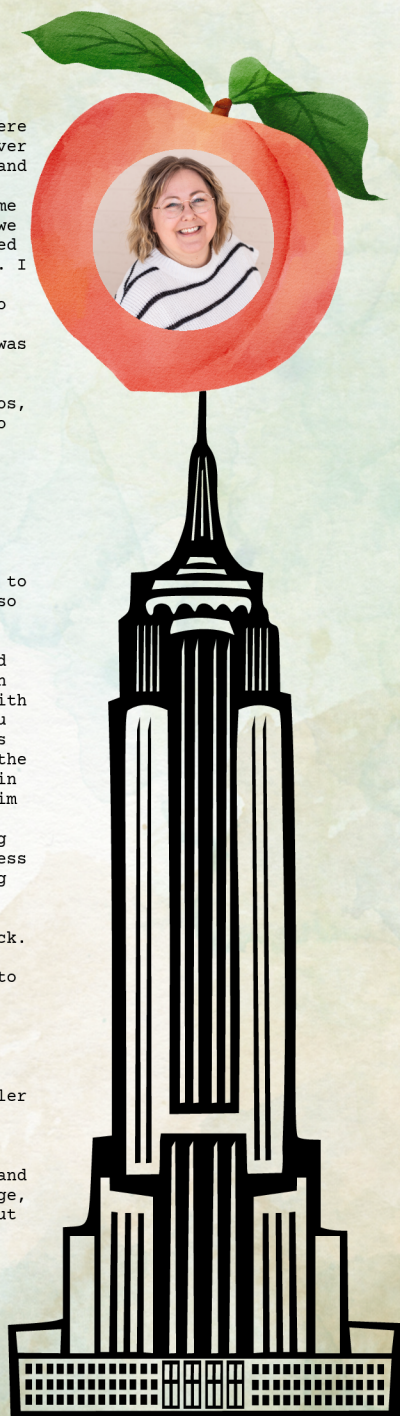

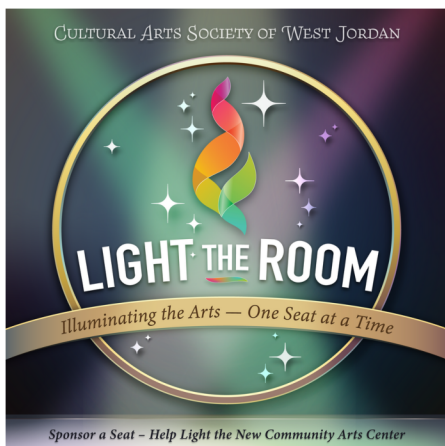
